



## Live Tree Stand

### Assembly Materials:

4 tree stand legs      1 tree stand base



#### Stand Levelers- 4

Keep your stand in one location by using the stand levelers. Adjusting how far you screw in the leveler will straighten up a crooked tree.



#### Pins - 4

Use the pins to secure the legs in the tree stand base.



#### Eyebolts - 4

Use the eyebolts to secure your tree in the tree stand.

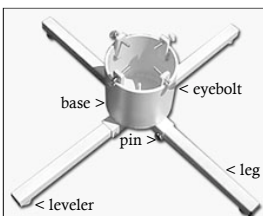

**\*No tools needed for assembly of stand. Drill and 3/4" wood bit are needed to drill hole in the bottom of the tree trunk to accommodate stand spike located in the base.**

### Assembly and Set Up Instructions:

1. Prior to placing your fresh tree in the stand, drill a 3" hole in the bottom of the tree to accommodate the spike at the bottom of the tree stand using a 3/4" wood bit.
2. Screw casters or stand levelers into openings on the bottom end of each stand leg.
3. Insert leg in openings under tree stand base.
4. Push pins through holes on each leg and base to attach legs to the base.
5. Remove nuts from large eye bolts. Turn bolts through the four holes on the upper portion of the stand. Nuts can be then screwed onto the end if desired and used to secure the bolt in the stand.
6. After placing your tree in the stand, screw bolts tightly against the trunk of the tree to secure it in the stand.
7. Lock wheels in place once your tree is positioned in its permanent location by pushing down the lock lever.

#### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Take care of your tree stand after use by completely drying the inside base of the stand and repackaging it in the box provided before storing it. Rewrap legs and base in the protective plastic wrap to help prevent scratches in the finish. Each tree stand is handmade with great care, but some imperfections may be seen.
